



The Yale-China Medical Student Exchange Program
Application Announcement
December 2012

Description

The Yale-China Medical Student Exchange Program strives to enhance the capacity of international medicine of the fellowship recipients at Xiangya School of Medicine and Yale School of Medicine, as well as affiliated hospitals and institutions. Under the Exchange Program, medical students at Xiangya School of Medicine in Changsha, China and the Yale School of Medicine in New Haven, CT will travel to the other school for month-long clinical observership/rotation to learn about health care in the other cultural setting.

For 2012-2013, there are 4 program-funded fellowships and 4 self-funded positions for medical students at Xiangya School of Medicine.

Program Structure

In late April of 2013 (self-funded group) and again in late June of 2013 (for program-funded group), selected Xiangya medical students will travel to New Haven for the month-long experience. For program-funded students, the program will pay for housing and utilities, reimbursement for food and other expenses, and medical insurance for each individual for up to one month, tuition cost for the Xiangya medical students for the month-long rotation at Yale, transportation to and from the airport in the U.S. to New Haven, Connecticut. In addition, Yale-China will also provide other logistical and administrative support as necessary.

Focus Areas for Xiangya Medical students:

Placement is possible in Anesthesiology, Child Study Center, Emergency Medicine, Genetics, Internal Medicine, Neurology, Obstetrics, Gynecology & Reproductive Sciences, Ophthalmology and Visual Science, Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation, Pathology, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Radiology and Therapeutic Radiology, Religion and Medicine, and Surgery.
